

## VIRTUAL GAMES

**PLAY AT HOME WITH FAMILY OR ONLINE WITH FRIENDS!**

**Activity: Rainbow Race**

**Number of Players: Minimum 2**

**Supplies/Set-up: None**

### Instructions

- On your mark, get set, go!
- The first person who returns with three items of a predetermined color is the winner.
- Repeat with other colors.
- To make it more challenging, you can create rules such as the objects “must be in this room” or “must be smaller than your hand.”
- You can also do this with the alphabet. Who can be the first to find three things that all start with B?
- Assign points to each round. First player to reach 5 points wins

**Activity: Family Feud**

**Number of Players: Minimum 3**

**Supplies/ Set-up: “Host” to have copy of answer key**

### Instructions

- Start by picking a host and creating 2 teams with the remaining players. Host will be the only one you can see the questions and answer key (see below)
- The Host proposes the question (ex: name something that usually comes in pairs)
- Team one tries to reveal all the correct answers to the question before receiving three strikes. If they are successful, they win the points (number of points listed next to the answers on the answer key)
- If the team receives three strikes without clearing the board, control is passed to the next team.
- The next team then has three opportunities to guess the rest of the answers. For each correct answer a team guesses, they get the points associated with that answer.
- Each team tries to collect the most points – the team with the most point wins!

**Activity: Guess the Definition**

**Number of Players: Minimum 2**

**Supplies/Set-up: paper, pencil, dictionary**

**Instructions**

- Player 1 chooses a word from the dictionary (try to pick words that we don't often hear) and writes down the definition.
- All other players write down what they think the definition of the word is – WITHOUT looking it up!
- Each person shares what they think the word means
- Then, each person votes on the definition they believe is correct.
- A point is awarded to each player who gets the definition correct.
- A point is awarded to each player who created a definition that received a vote.
- If no one guesses votes for the correct definition, the person selecting the word is awarded two points.
- Decide on the point total to declare the winner (e.g., play to 20.)

**Activity: Last Letter**

**Number of Players: Minimum 2**

**Supplies/Set-up: None**

**Instructions**

- Choose a category of words. For Example, "Food"
- Choose the first word. The first person pronounces it. i.e. "Banana"
- The second person must begin the name of another word using the last letter of the first word. i.e. "Apple"
- Keep going until someone can't come up with a word.

**Activity: 20 Questions**

**Number of Players: Minimum 2**

**Supplies/Set-up: None**

**Instructions**

- Split players into teams of 2
- Think of a person, place, or thing.
- The other team (or other person if you are playing in pairs) can ask you up to 20 questions in order to gather information.
- You can only answer "Yes" or "No."
- See if they can guess what you're thinking of before they run out of questions! If the other team/person guesses before the 20 questions are up, they get a point.

**Activity: Charades**

**Number of Players: Minimum 2**

**Supplies/Set-up: A stopwatch/timing device, notepad and pencil for scorekeeping,**

**Instructions**

- Choose a player to start the game.
- The player thinks of a book title, a famous person's name, a saying, a movie title or a song title to act out.
- They should choose something with which the others will be familiar.
- If you like, designate a category like sports or Disney.
- The player then acts out the word or phrase they've chosen to the other players. Remember: if you are playing virtually, make sure the other team/players can fully see your actions
- The first person to guess the word or phrase gets a point.
- Players from each team take turns acting for their teammates.
- Keep track of the points earned by each player or team. The one with the most points at the end of the game wins.

Here are some common clues used in charades:

- To indicate a book, pretend to read a book.
- To indicate a song, pretend to sing.
- To indicate a movie, pretend to crank an old movie camera.
- To indicate the number of words, hold up that many fingers.
- To act out a word that rhymes with the word you want players to guess, first tug on your ear to say "sounds like."
















**Activity: Guess Who**

































**Number of Players: Minimum 2**

**Supplies/Set-up: Ensure each player has a copy of the character sheet below**

**Instructions**

- Select one player to start by picking a character from the Character Sheet.
- The object of the game is to guess which character your opponent picked.
- Each player gets one yes or no question per turn and may only guess (to win the game) once per game.
- If a player successfully guesses their opponents hidden character, then they win; if their guess is wrong then they lose.
