INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS

Contractors are advised that Addendum No. 1 to 1220-040-2021-038 is hereby issued by the City. This addendum shall form part of the contract documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. The following information is provided to answer questions raised by Contractors for the above-named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractors or any sub-contractor not being familiar with this addendum. This Addendum No. 1 contains two (2) pages.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

- Q1. Ref Dwg no. M0.01, "Boiler Transportation scope": We would like to disassemble the Boiler in our own shop by manufacturer's authorized Technician. Then transporting, craning, and moving the Boiler package in the mechanical room and reassemble as required by the same technician. Taking the full responsibility
- A1. Disassembly of the boiler(s) by a manufacturers authorized/certified technician is approved.

and maintaining manufacturer's warranty, whether this action would be acceptable.

- Q2. We understand Bid Bond or Surety's consents will not be required.
- A2. Bid Bond or Surety's consents are not required.
- Q3. We understand, existing concrete Pads to remain. The new boilers to be installed on the Pad without any concrete modifications.
- A3. Correct, unless approved by the civic facilities representative.
- Q4. Ref. Section 21 05 01, 1.12, Spare Parts: The contents are not very specific, do any spare parts required to be provided?

A4. Spare parts to be pulled from the old boiler(s) by civic facilities staff - No spare parts needed to be provided for the new boilers.

- Q5. Ref. Section 21 05 01, 2.4 Asbestos: I believe Contractor is not to deal with asbestos or hazardous materials, please confirm.
- A5. Contractor is responsible for any hazardous materials. (i.e., Valve packing, refractory, gaskets)
- Q6. Ref. 3.2 System Cleaning: "Clean interior and exterior of all systems including strainers", whether this task is part of the scope?
- A6. Yes, this is part of the scope.
- Q7. For system commissioning, whether any 3rd party commission agent is required to be engaged?
- A7. Third party commissioning will be set up and conducted by a Civic Facilities chosen firm.

 - .1 Contractor to refer asbestos analysis report before commencing any work. If asbestos is present within the existing insulation, Contractor to hire certified professionals to carry out abatement.
 - 3. Note 24 to Boiler (Gas Fired) Schedule:
 - .1 Gas supply pressure to be in the ranger of 4" 14" WC (8" 10" for ideal operation). Gas regulator to be vented type only.
