## **INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS**

This Addendum is issued to provide additional information to the RFQ for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractor not being familiar with this Addendum. This Addendum No. 2 contains one (1) page in total.

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

Q1: Section 2.1.1 sub (n)

Start & run generator. How long do you want us to run the generator per month?

- A1: The City estimates this may take one (1) hour but the Contractor should provide their recommendation.
- Q2: Section 2.1.1 sub (o)

Exercise transfer switch. Do you mean doing a transfer test and run it for an hour? Or just to make sure it transfers?

- A2: The transfer switches need to be tested to ensure they operate in an emergency power outage.
- Q3: For the three "afterhours" units, what is the earliest time we can come to site for the respective services?
- A3: These would generally be done on weekends or after 6:00 PM, site dependent working around operational requirements which vary from location to location.
