A. DELEGATIONS

1. Mugs Stoller Clayton Heights Association File: 0065-012; 2350-002

Mugs Stoller was in attendance to express the concerns of the Clayton Heights Association regarding the intersection of 184th Street and Fraser Highway, and extension of 188th Street to Fraser Highway. Ms. Stoller advised:

- That the community is concerned with the existing traffic impact on Clayton Heights School.
- That 90% of the school catchment is on the south side of the Fraser Highway.
- That residents were told that 188th Street would be extended and that traffic lights with left hand turns would be installed at 188th and 184th.
- That there is severe traffic congestion at 184th Street as drivers attempt to turn onto Fraser Highway.
- That 68th Avenue is now blocked off to traffic as a result of numerous vehicles using it as a shortcut.
- That it is impossible to make turns on or off the Fraser Highway.
- That there can be as many as 86 cars backed up at the intersection, with even more during rush hour.
- That traffic congestion causes many angry drivers.
- That they need 188th opened up as soon as possible to help alleviate traffic congestion.
- That the sidewalk along 184th should be updated and upgraded to meet the current demand.

Councillor Higginbotham entered the meeting at 4:48 p.m.

Ms. Stoller concluded by advising that the residents have received the happy news that 188th Street will be extended through to Fraser Highway in January 2002, and that left hand turn signals will be installed at 184th and 188th. She stated that these

improvements were promised 4 years ago and asked that they not be stalled due to red tape.
