1. Mike Powley, Coordinator OPCA/OPALS Traffic Calming Project Ocean Park Community Association Ocean Park Seniors Group Surrey Association of Sustainable Communities File: 5460-15; 0550-20-10

> Mike Powley, Coordinator, OPCA/OPALS Traffic Calming Project, Ocean Park Community Association, Ocean Park Seniors Group, and Shirley Stonier, Surrey Association of Sustainable Communities, were in attendance present the findings from the Ocean Park Community Association's Task Force on Traffic Calming in the Ocean Park area.

Mr. Powley provided the following comments:

- The Ocean Park Area Livability Study (OPALS) highlighted four issues related to traffic calming and community theme: a sense of safety, traffic calming, locations of new or improved sidewalks and theme considerations ("village concept").
- The study is not about traffic volume but rather control of "over the speed limit" traffic flow.
- There are four intersections of particular concern requiring traffic calming measures:
 - o 128 Street and 16 Avenue
 - o 130 Street and Marine Drive
 - o 128 Street and 24 Avenue
 - o 124 Street and 24 Avenue
- Some traffic calming measures to be considered are raised speed humps, signage, traffic circles, and crosswalks.
- In addition, sidewalks are required at certain locations as well as "border" signage ("Welcome to Ocean Park").

- A CD of the PowerPoint presentation was presented to the City Clerk for distribution.
- The RCMP provided a courtesy speed watch program on October 16, 2004 and it was noted that many vehicles were well over the speed limit.
