In attendance before Council to make a presentation regarding the 2000 Fleetwood Town Centre Plan – 10 Years After.

The following comments were made:

- Delegation provided a brief historical overview of the land use plan for the Fleetwood Community from 1996 – 2001 and noted other communities within the City of Surrey are showing a steady increase in population while Fleetwood is projected to remain relatively static from 2011 - 2041.
- The delegation suggested that further work could be done toward improving the character and urban design concept of the neighbourhood in an effort to inspire future growth and development.
- A sense of community could be achieved by adding bench seating in public areas, creating walkable neighbourhoods and thoughtful road treatments.
- Removal / reduction of wire fences, implementing signage standards would help to clean-up the community and make it more welcoming. Streetscapes for commercial areas need to seriously be reconsidered, as it is the gateway to the New Town Centre.

The delegation requested the City of Surrey to engage the Fleetwood Community to explore how further enhancements can be made toward developing the community and realizing the goals of the 10-Year Community Plan.

Staff noted they will continue to work with the Fleetwood Community Association.
