A. DELEGATIONS

1. Rick Faw, Vice-President of Programming, A Rocha Canada File: 0520-01; 0550-20-10

In attendance before Council to provide a presentation regarding A Rocha Canada and its mandate and activity within the City.

The following comments were made:

- A Rocha Canada, is part of an international Christian conservation organization that is involved in conservation projects, community gardens, sustainable agriculture, multi-generational ecological education, and scientific research.
- A Rocha began its work in Canada in 2000, establishing its first Field Study Centre in BC. This Centre was located in the Little Campbell Watershed.
- In addition to restoration and conservation work on the river, the work in BC focused on research, community agriculture, sustainable living, and environmental education programs, hosting over 2,000 students every year.
- The Brooksdale Environmental Centre is home to A Rocha's national office and is the new hub of A Rocha's work in the Vancouver area.
- Brooksdale is situated near the Pacific Coast in British Columbia, just north
 of the Canada-USA border. The property includes environmentally
 sensitive land along the Little Campbell River, which supports a diversity of
 birds, plants, insects and fish.
 - The goal of A Rocha Canada's Little Campbell River Watershed Stewardship Project is to protect biodiversity and improve watershed health through research, education, and practical action. This project includes three major elements:
 - o Surveys and research
 - Landowner education and engagement

- Practical habitat restoration
- The donation of Brooksdale, a 4.1 million dollar heritage property to A Rocha Canada, a local conservation organization, was recently completed in December of 2015.
- Now that this legacy gift from the Neufeld family has been donated A
 Rocha is moving ahead with capital improvements, beginning with the
 historic barn, renovating it into a world-class conservation and education
 centre to welcome the public and train students of all ages.
 - A Rocha's Sustainable Agriculture program helps individuals and families grow in the ability to eat "in season".
 - Education is one of the pillars of A Rocha's work in Canada. Over 10,000 children and youth engage every year in our various environmental education programs across Canada. A Rocha's environmental education curriculum is available to the public.

Council extended appreciation to the delegation and all the good work that is being undertaken by the organization.
