In attendance before Council to provide a presentation for the New Westminster & District Labour Council (NWDLC) Day of Mourning. The following information was highlighted:

- The NWDLC's Day of Mourning has been scheduled for April 28, 2017 at Westminster Pier Park in New Westminster.
- The City of Surrey and CUPE 402 will honor the Day of Mourning on April 28, 2017 at Surrey Operations Centre at 7:30 a.m.
- The Day of Mourning is meant to remember individuals who have been lost on the job, and to renew a commitment to creating healthy and safe workplaces.
- In 2004, the Westray Amendment was signed into law, and established new legal duties for workplace health and safety.
- In 2016, 144 workers lost their lives due to work related injuries or illness.
- One-third of workers injured on the job are young people.
- The "Alive After 5" program aims to provide education regarding work safety.

Council commended NWDLC for their work regarding workplace safety.
