The delegation provided a PowerPoint presentation regarding the programs and workshops that are offered in Surrey by the British Columbia Centre on Substance Use and highlighted the following information:

- "Stronger Together" is a family capacity-building project that is being coordinated across the province. The goal of "Stronger Together" is to identify systemic gaps, barriers to accessing harm reduction and treatment services and strategies for supporting substance users and their families.
- It is estimated that there are 145 individuals affected when one person passes away from drug use yet the number of overdose-related deaths in BC is not being treated as a crisis.
- Surrey was selected as one of eight host communities for dialogue and learning sessions. The sessions identified issues related to substance use and the overdose crisis, such as healthcare, confidentiality and patient rights, "flop houses" and finances. In addition, it was found that increased distribution and use of naloxone kits, normalization of substance use conversations, social justice teachers in school programs, peer connections, mentorship and client-centred models are all examples of ideas and programs that are currently working well to address the overdose crisis.
