The delegation provided a PowerPoint presentation regarding the 2020 Coldest Night of the Year walk in White Rock, B.C. and highlighted the following information:

- The Coldest Night of the Year is an annual two, five or ten kilometre fundraising walk held across Canada to support the hungry and the homeless. There are three walks in Surrey and White Rock on February 20, 2020, located at Memorial Park, North Surrey and Cloverdale.
- In 2019, the White Rock walk raised over \$116,000 for homeless prevention services. There were 44 teams with a total of 412 participants. The White Rock location was ranked in the top 10 out of 123 locations across Canada.
- The 2017 Metro Vancouver Homeless Count identified approximately 600 unhoused individuals in Surrey and White Rock, which was a 50% increase from the 2014 count. The funds raised from the 2019 Coldest Night of the Year walk in White Rock provided support to over 360 individuals who were either homeless or at-risk of becoming unhoused.
