The delegation provided a PowerPoint presentation regarding the Metro 2050 Update and highlighted the following information:

- Metro Vancouver Regional Planning and Housing Services provides a strategic, long-range, cross boundary, interdisciplinary lens and is responsible for developing, implementing and stewarding the region's growth strategy. *Metro 2040* was adopted in 2011 by all member jurisdictions. In April 2019, the Metro Vancouver Board approved the process to update the regional growth strategy. The new document will be *Metro 2050* and will continue to use effective tools such as urban containment boundaries, urban centres and frequent transit development areas, regional land use designations and sewerage extension policies.
- The regional growth strategy is built on solid planning principles, such as locating growth in appropriate places, protecting important lands, and supporting complete communities, diverse and affordable housing, better mobility, a prosperous economic and efficient urban infrastructure.
- *Metro 2050* will update growth projections, integrate with *Transport 2050* (the regional transportation document), and strengthen and update policies regarding climate change, housing, the environment, structuring growth and consider equity. It is anticipated that a draft document will be made available for comments in 2021 and that a final version will be ready for adoption by July 2022.
- Metro Vancouver adopted a formal engagement plan that focuses on those most directly affected and specific policy areas. Different approaches will

be made to engage plan signatories, non-signatory stakeholders, First Nations and the public.
