Canada Cup Women's Softball Tournament

The delegation provided a PowerPoint update regarding the 2022 Canada Cup Women's Softball Tournament and highlighted the following information:

- The Canada Cup International Softball tournament will be celebrating its 26th anniversary. 1500 elite athletes from National and Club level teams will participating. It is anticipated that teams from Canada, USA, Australia, Mexico, Chinese Taipei, Netherlands and Czech Republic, amongst others, will participate.
- Team Canada has selected the Canada Cup to host its official public medal celebration for their bronze win at the Tokyo 2021 Olympic Games. The celebration is scheduled for Friday, June 24, 2022 on the championship diamond and will include International Olympic Committee and Canadian Sport dignitaries.
- Melanie Matthews, an Earl Marriott Secondary graduate, will be inducted into the World Baseball Softball Confederation (WBSC) Hall of Fame on June 23, 2022 at the championship diamond. Ms. Matthews has spent nearly a decade with the Canadian national program and is recognized as one of the all-time best hitters. Ms. Matthews will be one of 17 Canadians to be inducted into the WBSC Hall of Fame.
