That Council pass a resolution to close the meeting

to the public pursuant to Section 90 (1)(a) (c) (e) (f) (g) (h) (i) and (k), and Section 90(2) (b) of the Community Charter, which states:

- A part of a council meeting may be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to or is one or more of the following:
  - (a) personal information about an identifiable individual who holds or is being considered for a position as an officer, employee or agent of the municipality or another position appointed by the municipality;
  - labour relations or other employee relations; (c)
  - (e) the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the interest of the municipality;
  - (f) law enforcement, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the conduct of an investigation under or enforcement of an enactment;
  - litigation or potential litigation affecting the municipality; (g)
  - an administrative tribunal hearing or potential administrative tribunal hearing affecting the (h) municipality, other than a hearing to be conducted by the council or a delegate of council;
  - the receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications (i) necessary for that purpose;
  - (k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interest of the municipality if they were held in public; and
- A part of a council meeting must be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to one or more of the following:
  - the consideration of information received and held in confidence relating to negotiations (b) between the municipality and a provincial government or the federal government or both, or

	between a provincial govern	nment or the federal government or both and a third party."
